

# 1 GETTING LUCIDCHART FOR ACADEMICS

*LucidChart (www.lucidchart.com) is an excellent diagramming tool, but finding the educational version is tricky.*

## First, download the tool which is free for academic purposes

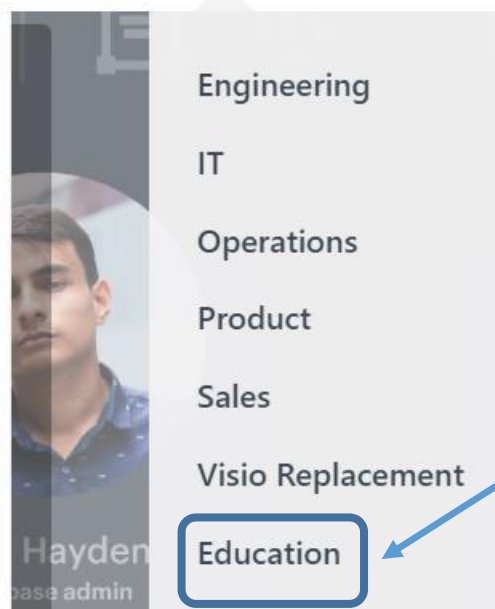
The first step is to go to [www.lucidchart.com](http://www.lucidchart.com) where the top of the screen should look like this:



## Finding the Educational Version

This is the last item under the **Solutions** menu item:

Fill in the box asking for an EDU address (an educational account such as .ac.cy) with your full email address for that institution and then click the orange **Sign up free** button – done.
